
MailTight - Windows Phone 8 Configuration





Internet Email Account - Incoming email server




Enter your **Account name** description (e.g. your email address or *MailTight email*)
Enter **Your Name** as you want it to be displayed in emails sent from your Windows Phone 8
For your **Incoming email server** enter: *mail.mailtight.com*

For **Account type**, you can select how your Windows Phone 8 downloads your email. If you select *IMAP4*, your email account will work well with multiple devices and your mailbox will be available and consistent across all devices (e.g. delete an email on your phone and it will be removed from your laptop too). Your email is stored encrypted and securely on a MailTight server in a location of your choice. If you lose your phone or laptop, you will still have all your email on the server.

If you select *POP3*, your email account will work well with just your phone but will not be synchronised with other devices, such as your laptop. You should generally use this setting if you want to store your email locally on your Windows Phone 8 and do not want any email kept on a MailTight server after it has been downloaded.






